Tombola donation handed over to St. Nikolaus children's hospice in Bad Grönenbach

- **Tombola instead of Christmas party - a spontaneous idea of the employees of the Bavarian company MAHA Maschinenbau Haldenwang becomes a huge success. The proceeds of the raffle were doubled by the company and finally donated as a total of 2,600 Euros in March 2021 to the children's hospice St. Nikolaus in Bad Grönenbach, Bavaria.**

What started out as a small idea ended up exceeding all expectations. "The interest and participation were overwhelming. Many of the colleagues paid in much more money than drew raffle tickets," report the initiators of the campaign Pia Hitzlberger, Monika Kaufmann and Nadine Jenn.

Thanks to the numerous participants, a total of 1,272 Euros was collected via the Tombola. The company MAHA doubled the amount again to 2,600 Euros. The collected amount was donated with great pleasure to the children's hospice St. Nikolaus in Bad Grönenbach in March 2021. The children's hospice accompanies families with an incurable and life-shortening child during the entire illness, dying and mourning phase.
